Coaches Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to live up to my responsibilities as a Deltona Youth Soccer Club and FYSA coach by following the Deltona Youth Soccer Club and FYSA's Code of Ethics. This means

- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
- I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- I will promise to review and practice the basic first aid principles needed to treat injuries of my players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.
- I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach, and I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
- I will treat parents and players of the opposing side and the Deltona side with respect.
- I will treat the referee and sideline judges with respect.

I hereby pledge to adhere to the Deltona Youth Soccer Club and FYSA Coaches Code of Ethics and fully understand if I do not uphold them, and can be put on suspension or dismissed.

Failure to comply with the above code of ethics may result in the suspension of your privilege to participate in club or FYSA sanctioned events, censure, and/or suspension of your coaching privileges for a period of time ranging from 30 days to 5 years, at the discretion of the DYSC club's ethics committee.
